Breeding Birds

The Mosses are an important site for rare ground nesting birds including Curlew & Lapwing. Curlew numbers in the UK declined by around 50% between 1995-2015.

Disturbance can cause ground nesting birds to abandon their nests or expose their eggs or young to predators.



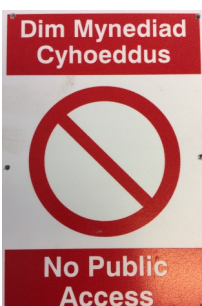
Please help us minimise disturbance by:
